



City High Indoor Facility Rules



THIS IS YOURS! PLEASE TREAT IT AS SUCH!

1. MOST IMPORTANT, EMPHASIZE SAFETY. The nets have some give so make certain kids are away from danger spots.
2. Please wrap up 5 minutes prior to your end time to allow for ample time for cleanup and for the next group to easily get in.
3. Make certain the cages are clean and the **nets are set up properly for the next group. DO NOT PLACE SCREEN LEGS ON NETS!!!**
4. Please respect the facility as if it were your home. Clean shoes, items picked up. **Use the broom to sweep when you are there.**
5. No hanging on the nets.
6. There is virtually no seating and **there is no bathroom**; the school will be open for restroom use in emergencies. Make sure to inform all families of this. Parents are welcome to bring seating, but there is very limited space for spectators.
7. Parking is not supposed to be in front of the building. You can park on Glendale and walk up the sidewalk as well as by the cafeteria, fine arts section of the school. **DO NOT DRIVE AROUND THE GATE!**
8. Baseballs/Softballs/Helmets and all equipment can go in the back storage area.
9. Make sure baseballs/Softballs DO NOT LEAVE the premises. This must be monitored by parents and coaches.
10. NO FOOD OR DRINK on the TURF!!!
